

Johnston County CIT Class 10

The 10th Johnston County Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) training academy was held August 10-14, 2015 and graduated its largest class to date of 17. Since December 2011, 110 law enforcement officers and other first responders have become certified CIT Officers through the Johnston County Mental Health Center and Johnston Community College. More than 89 of those are from Johnston County agencies. Last year Johnston County trained 20 people over the span of three training academies. This year, that number increased to 32 people trained over the span of two training academies. We are looking forward to continued growth in the CIT Program in Johnston County.
